Upon clicking the 'Share an Idea' button you will be presented with to the 'text editor' shown below. Here are the tools and settings that can be used to create your first post! Below is a short over view about how to use the various features.




Challenge Title

Challenge Content



The 'Tags' window allows you to input key words that are associated with your posts, this will aid other users to find your challenge as well as external search engines. To add key words or 'tags' enter your chosen words separating them with commas and click add to add them to the post.

Publishing

You can save your post at any point and come back to it later. You can do this by clicking the 'Save Draft' button. Once you are happy with the post you can publish it live on cracked-it by clicking the 'Publish button'.
